





Not only has your air conditioner been working overtime but it will have taken a toll on your furnace. Your furnace filters, blower etc. will be in real need of cleaning and servicing before those cold winter days start. Many of our customers call to ask when their furnace should be serviced. I always tell them, it should be serviced before you actually need it. We recommend late August or early September or after the summer heat has died down a little bit. A lot of customers wait until it's too late and it then becomes an emergency issue, rather than a regular maintenance.

Another common question is, how long should my furnace last? In most cases, a furnace lifespan is approximately 15 years, if serviced regularly.

We would also like to remind you that your gas fireplace also requires annual maintenance. Everyone always likes to see that dusty fireplace glass glistening.
